## 1: Role Overview.

The Squad First Aiders provide first aid cover at festivals, matches and training sessions.

## 2: Purpose.

The Squad First Aiders:

- Provide first aid cover at festivals, matches and training sessions.
- Ensure Coaches and Parents are fully briefed on key medical issues (e.g. Concussion Training).
- Work with the Squad Coaches and Officials to ensure that the Return to Play Protocols are followed especially in cases of concussion.

## 3: Requirements.

Squad First Aiders will need to:

- Either obtain an RFU Emergency First Aid qualification.
- Or hold a recognised First Aid qualification (e.g. HSE First Aid at Work qualification).
- Or work as an Allied Health Professional (e.g. Sports Rehabilitator) with appropriate experience and training in first aid and/or immediate care.
- Or work as a registered Health Care Professional (e.g. Doctor) with appropriate experience and training in immediate care.

## 4: Time Commitment.

- The Squad First Aiders will work as part of a team to provide first aid cover at matches, festivals and training sessions. As far as possible they will be asked to cover events that they would have been attending anyway.
