Codes of Conduct

Code of conduct for Mini & Junior Players.

The Club (CRFC) is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members.

The club believes that it is important that Mini/Junior players must, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, as a player you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

All Mini/Junior players:

- Must always abide by the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Must always respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Must always keep to the agreed timings for training sessions and competitions.
- Must always inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late for, or unable to be present at a training session or competition.
- Must always wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager. Head guards and shoulder pads must carry the IRB logo and the wearing of gum shields is mandatory.
- Must always pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Are NOT allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Are NOT allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
